### III. General professional experience:

For the past 44 years I have been in active practice as a litigator in New York and elsewhere in the U.S. For at least 30 of those years I have actively practiced in the bankruptcy courts in numerous jurisdictions and in all aspects of federal bankruptcy practice. Since 1956 I have been an attorney in continuous practice. From 1962 to 1968 I was an Assistant U.S. Attorney in the Southern District of New York and served as Chief of the Civil Division in that office.

### IV. General pertinent experience:

I served as an arbitrator with the American Arbitration Association and as a mediator and arbitrator in proceedings before the NY Public Employee Relations Board. I currently serve

as mediator in the USDC-SDNY and in the Supreme Court, New York County. I have handled numerous mediation and arbitration cases. I have also been involved in extensive collective bargaining negotiations, principally on behalf of employers.

**VI. Pertinent bankruptcy training:**
