III. General professional experience:

I have had 18 years of experience in complex cases under title 11 representing corporate and individual debtors, creditors, committees and trustees in chapter 11 and chapter 7 cases. I have been involved in all phases of debtor-creditor law, including workouts, secured transactions, negotiation and drafting of reorganization plans, disclosure statements, real estate sales contracts, lease assignments, lease modifications and bankruptcy litigation.

IV. General pertinent experience:

I have not had any direct mediation experience, either as a mediator or a participant. I have, however, in the course of my experience as an attorney, participated in settlement discussions and negotiations among various parties. I believe that mediation can be an effective alternative dispute resolution technique and can reduce the cost and time wasted through unnecessary litigation.

V. Mediation training:
