DUTIES OF DEBTORS – PROCEDURES RELATING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF BANKRUPTCY CODE § 521

The implementation of §521 of the Bankruptcy Code relating to the debtor's duties shall be governed by procedures contained in any applicable standing order issued by the Court.

Comment

The procedures relating to the implementation of §521 (a)(1) (B) of the Bankruptcy Code, which requires an individual debtor to provide payment advices or other evidence of payment received within 60 days before the filing of the petition, and of §521(i), which provides for dismissal of the case if certain information is not filed within 45 days after the commencement of the case, are governed by General Order [M-382](#) and any amendments or supplemental standing orders of the Court.
