WHEREAS it has been determined by this Judicial Council that the services of a retired bankruptcy judge are needed for the Southern District of New York, and

WHEREAS Jeremiah E. Berk has retired from service and has consented to serve as a recalled bankruptcy judge pursuant to the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §155(b) that Jeremiah E. Berk is recalled into service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge in the Southern District of New York, for a term effective December 22, 1999 through June 30, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Jeremiah E. Berk shall receive the salary of a full-time bankruptcy judge subject to the restrictions on the payment of an annuity in subchapter III of Chapter 83 of Title 5 of the United States Code, and shall be entitled to appoint a secretary and law clerk subject to the availability of funds.
