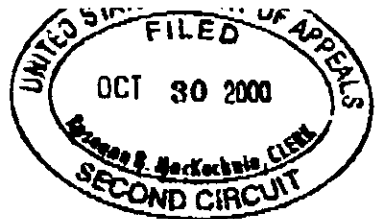


ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
