WHEREAS it has been determined by this Judicial Council that the services of a retired bankruptcy judge are needed for the Southern District of New York, and

WHEREAS **Burton R. Lifland** has retired from service and has consented to serve as a recalled bankruptcy judge pursuant to the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

Lifland** shall receive the salary of a full-time bankruptcy judge subject to the restrictions on the payment of an annuity in subchapter III of Chapter 83 of Title 5 of the United States Code, and shall be entitled to appoint a secretary and law clerk subject to the availability of funds.
