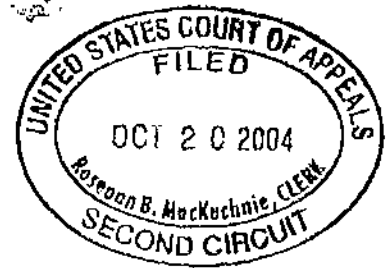

UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY
JUDGE

WHEREAS it has been determined by this Judicial Council that the services of a retired bankruptcy judge are needed for the Southern District of New York, and

WHEREAS **Cornelius Blackshear** has retired from service and has consented to serve as a recalled bankruptcy judge pursuant to the regulations promulgated by the Judicial Conference of the United States,

IT IS ORDERED pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §155(b) that **Cornelius Blackshear** is recalled into service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge in the Southern District of New York, for a term effective March 5, 2005 through March 4, 2008.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Cornelius Blackshear** shall receive the salary of a full-time bankruptcy judge subject to the restrictions on the payment of an annuity in subchapter III of Chapter 83 of Title 5 of the United States Code, and shall be entitled to appoint a secretary and law clerk subject to the availability of funds.
