THE DESIGNATION OF THE BANKRUPTCY JUDGE
AT WHITE PLAINS, NEW YORK, TO ACT IN ALL
CASES, PROCEEDINGS AND MATTERS FILED IN
OR ARISING IN POUGHKEEPSIE, NEW YORK.

The office of the bankruptcy judge for the Southern District of New York at Poughkeepsie, New York, having become vacant as of September 1, 1979, and it appearing that Section 43c of the 1898 Bankruptcy Act is applicable in respect of cases and all proceedings arising under that Act, and that such section is applicable to all cases and civil proceedings arising in cases filed on and after October 1, 1979 pursuant to Section 404(d) of Title IV of the 1978 Bankruptcy Reform legislation, and it appearing that the bankruptcy judge presently acting at White Plains, New York, be designated and assigned temporarily to act in all cases and proceedings under the 1898 Act and under the 1978 statute in all cases, matters, proceedings and civil proceedings emanating from the Poughkeepsie, New York office of the bankruptcy judge, until such time as a bankruptcy judge for Poughkeepsie, New York has assumed the duties of his office,

NOW, it is

ORDERED, that Bankruptcy Judge Howard Schwartzberg, with offices at White Plains, New York, be and he hereby is designated and assigned temporarily to act in respect

of all cases and matters pertaining thereto filed in Poughkeepsie, New York, under the 1898 Act, and in all cases, matters and civil proceedings arising in cases filed under the 1978 Bankruptcy Reform legislation, and it is further

ORDERED, that Bankruptcy Judge Howard Schwartzberg of White Plains, New York, be and he hereby is designated to exercise the concurrent jurisdiction given the Bankruptcy Court in Poughkeepsie, New York, to handle cases arising within the Northern District of New York, with respect to Ulster, Sullivan and Greene Counties, and it is further

ORDERED, that the above designations and temporary assignments are nunc pro tunc as of September 1, 1979.
