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WHEREAS, the Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule (the “Miscellaneous Schedule”), promulgated pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1930(b), prescribes a charge of for public access to Court information and data (the “PACER Fees”) through the Court’s Internet web site, www.nysb.uscourts.gov ; and

WHEREAS, the Court is authorized to exempt persons and classes of persons from the payment of the PACER Fees in order to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to such information; and

WHEREAS, trustees appointed in subchapter V of chapter 11 require access to the Court’s electronic database to fulfill their statutory obligations; it is

ORDERED, trustees duly appointed under 11 U.S.C. § 1183 are exempt from payment of the PACER Fees for all trustee-related use.
