### **III. General professional experience:**

Law and mediation experience is described briefly below:

In the summer of 1975, prior to my third year of law school, I served as an extern-law clerk to The Honorable Frank K. Richardson, Associate Justice, California Supreme Court. Upon graduation, I served a one-year clerkship with The Honorable William H. Orrick, Jr., United States District Court, Northern District of California. From 1977 to 1986, I served as an Assistant Deputy Public Defender, NJ Office of the Public Defender, Newark, NJ. In this capacity, I served first as a staff attorney for the Child Advocacy Program, with particular experience in all aspects of appellate practice, including arguments before the Appellate Division and the NJ Supreme Court. Later, I was a Law Guardian, representing children in litigated child abuse and neglect cases. From 1986 until 1993, I was a member of Pfaltz & Woller, P.A., Summit, NJ, a general practice law firm in which I concentrated on appellate practice, family law, and representing a lender in commercial mortgage transactions. From 1995-1998, I worked as an Associate Director and then as a conflict resolution consultant at the NJ Center for Law-Related Education, Seton Hall University, South Orange, NJ, developing and implementing conflict resolution training programs for teachers, students, guidance counselors, parents and police officers. From 1993 to 2003 I had my own family mediation practice in Summit, NJ, and was Of Counsel to my Summit, NJ, firm. From 2000-2002, I was a contract mediator for the Association for Children of New Jersey, mediating litigated child abuse and neglect cases in Superior Court of NJ, Family Division, Essex County, NJ. From 2003-2007, I was a child welfare and matrimonial mediator employed by

the Superior Court of NJ, Family Division, Essex County, NJ. In 2006-2007, I was also a contract mediator for the Dispute Resolution Center, Orange County, NY, mediating in these same types of cases. Since 2007, I have served as a volunteer mediator with the Dispute Resolution Center, Kingston, NY, mediating issues including custody and visitation, parent-child conflicts, and business disputes.
