III. General professional experience:

I served as a law clerk for the Hon. Charles L. Briant (U.S.D.J., S.D.N.Y., 1981-82). After that, I was associated with Sullivan & Cromwell (1982-1989) during which time I was a litigator, specializing in complex commercial law cases and bankruptcy litigation. I then joined Milbank Tweed Hadley & McCloy as a Senior Attorney in Litigation in which I continued my focus upon complex commercial law cases and bankruptcy litigation. On March 1, 1993, I was appointed as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Eastern District of New York and served my full 14-year term until February 28, 2007. I was also appointed as United States Chief Bankruptcy Judge for the E.D.N.Y. on November 28, 2006 and served in that capacity until I left the bench.

IV. General pertinent experience:

During my tenure as United States Bankruptcy Judge, I participated in numerous settlement conferences and, from time to time, mediated cases that were pending before other bankruptcy judges. I was also instrumental in establishing a mediation program in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of New York.

V. Mediation training:

I have lectured extensively about mediation and, specifically, about the different approaches utilized by mediators during the course of mediation. I have also lectured on the topic of disinterestedness and the importance of the same for mediators. While I have participated in programs designed to train judicial officers as mediators, I have not participated in such a program for lawyers.
