### **III. General professional experience:**

I practiced law for over 30 years as a litigator with the New York office of Baker & McKenzie. I was an associate from 1973 to 1979 and a partner from 1979 until my retirement in October of 2003 when I joined JAMS as the Executive Director of JAMS Arbitration Practice. I have been a full-time mediator and arbitrator ever since.

### **IV. General pertinent experience:**

I have acted as a mediator in over 100 cases, including bankruptcy matters. In November 2003, I was appointed as one of five arbitrator/mediators by the Bankruptcy Court to assist in the resolution of the contested claims of unsecured creditors in the *Matter of GCO Securities LLC and GFinancial, LLC* (f/k/a Gruntal & Co.), Case Nos. 02-15360 and 02-15361 (ALG).

**V. Mediation training:**

The programs in which I have participated are described below (including course, program sponsor and hours): JAMS internal mediation training (4 full days) in October 2004; JAMS internal mediation programs (app. 16 hours since 2004) I have also lectured on international mediation at symposiums sponsored by JAMS and by Fordham Law School.

**VI. Pertinent bankruptcy training:**

Some of my practice with Baker & McKenzie involved representing clients in the Bankruptcy Court. Among other matters, I served as the Secretary of the Creditors Committee of St. Clare's Hospital and Health Center (I believe in the early 1980s). I also served as a Chairman of a Creditors Committee of a company (I cannot recall the name) in the business of making rubber and plastic consumer goods for home use. I also regularly advised clients on preference law and other bankruptcy matters, filed proofs of claims, etc. I have at least one reported bankruptcy opinion. See, *In the Matter of R.M. Cordova Int'l Inc.*, 77 B.R. 441 (Bkrcty. N.J. 1987). I have also acted as an arbitrator resolving commercial disputes arbitrated in the context of bankruptcy proceedings after one of the parties obtained a lifting of the automatic stay to enable the claim to be arbitrated.
