- 7. Indicate by their demeanor, character, and personality that they would exhibit judicial temperament if appointed or reappointed
- 8. Be of sound physical and mental health sufficient to perform the essential duties of the office
- 9. Must not be related by blood or marriage to a judge of the appointing court of appeals or judicial council of that circuit, or to a judge of the district court to be served, within the degrees specified in **28 U.S.C. § 458** at the time of the initial appointment.
