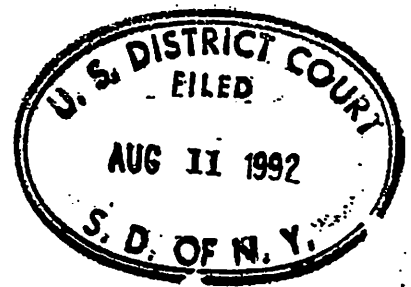


Pursuant to an amended order filed on June 2, 1992 Bankruptcy Judge Cornelius Blackshear submitted to the District Court a report on the status of all 1898 Bankruptcy Act cases pending as of July 31, 1992,

The report showing that continued progress has been made by the Bankruptcy Court in closing Act cases,
