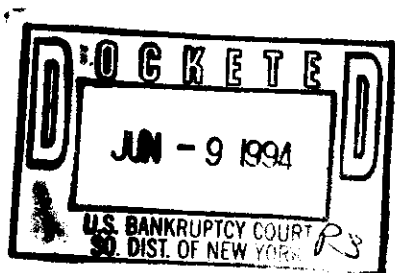
STANDING ORDER

M-132

WHEREAS, the members of the panel of private trustees in the Southern District of New York appointed by the United States Trustee are currently eligible and available to serve in cases under Chapter 7 of Title 11 to which they may be assigned; and


WHEREAS, all mail addressed to a corporate or partnership debtor is property of the debtor's estate pursuant to §541 of the Bankruptcy Code and may be a valuable asset to the administration of the debtor's estate; and upon showing of proper proof of appointment by the United States Trustee in a particular Chapter 7 case, a Trustee in a Chapter 7 case would be entitled to obtain mail addressed to such corporate or partnership debtor from the United States Postal Service; it is hereby

ORDERED, that upon presentation by a Chapter 7 Trustee of his or her appointment by the United States Trustee in a Chapter 7 corporate or partnership bankruptcy case to the United States Postal Service requesting that the mail be directed to him or her as such Trustee, the United States Postal Service is hereby ordered



and directed to redirect such mail to the Trustee until further order of this Court.
