In re Tolling of Deadlines Applicable to the Office of the United States Trustee Pending the Restoration of Department of Justice Funding

General Order M-657

Considering the lapse of funding to the United States Department of Justice, and to facilitate the management of the Court's docket, it is hereby ordered as follows:

- (1) Absent other direction or order from the Court, all deadlines for the filing of pleadings, briefs or other documents in bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings are hereby tolled with respect to the Office of the United States Trustee for Region 2 ("Office of the U.S. Trustee") during the duration of the government shutdown and extended thereafter for a period of time equal to the number of calendar days between September 30, 2025, and the date the President signs into law a budget appropriation that restores funding to the United States and/or such executive branch agencies.
- (2) With respect to all motions, applications or proceedings, nothing in this Order shall preclude the Office of the U.S. Trustee from applying to the assigned judge for a stay of such motion, application or proceeding on a case-by-case basis.

(3) The Office of the U.S. Trustee shall notify the Court immediately upon the restoration of Department of Justice funding.
